- identifies the differences between a healthy hook-up, a regretted hook-up and a sexual assault
- unpacks the importance and necessity of consent
- examines perpetrators' use of hook-up culture norms, such as alcohol, to mask true intentions
- breaks through the myth that rape is really just a regretted sexual experience
- provides techniques for successful bystander intervention
